

Volunteer Guidelines:

- Volunteers are not allowed to work on any project outside the scope of which is approved.
- Volunteers are not allowed to be on the roof of any residence, garage, or other outbuilding, unless licensed and insured for safety reasons.
- Projects involving power equipment such as lawnmowers, “weed whackers”, and saws may be used, but the Volunteer has the right to use their own tools and equipment.

“How do I get help?”

- ✓ Must be an Alcona County resident.
- ✓ Fill out an application so we know what your needs are. (See list of volunteer jobs)
- ✓ Application must be approved by the Volunteer Coordinator prior to Volunteer placement.
- ✓ Must own the home or provide written permission from the owner if modifications are being done.
- ✓ Materials to be used for a “fix-it” job must be purchased by the client. Assistance may be available.
- ✓ Client must be available for a pre-work inspection and present when volunteers are

available to do the requested work.

- ✓ Sign a release of liability form. (on application)
- ✓ Provide a copy of your homeowners insurance naming ACCOA as additional insured for minor home repairs if necessary.
